Household Pets

Although Kansas City, MO city ordinance permits up to four (4) pets per household, the Auburn Hills by-laws supersedes this ordinance and permits only two (2) pets per household. See the bylaws article IV(c) wherein it states "No

wild, semi-wild or domestic mammals, reptiles or birds may be kept or maintained upon any of the lots hereby restricted without the written consent of the developers or the Association, except that no more than two dogs, two cats, two rabbits, or

two birds, or any combination of the foregoing specific animals listed in this exception not exceeding the aggregate of two, may be kept on any such lots without such consent. AHHA has received numerous repeated complaints regarding excessive animals and animal control is investigating.
